Pattern Notes

Cable Round:

*K1, p2, slip 3 to cable needle and
hold in back, knit three, knit three
from cable needle, p2, k1 *

Seed Stitch:

Round 1: *k1, p1 *

Round 2: *p1, k1 *

Supplies

1 Skein Malabrigo Worsted
(shown in Abril)
5 4.5 mm (US 7) DPN
Darning needle
Waste yarn
Marker

Instructions

Cast on 36 stitches
Divide evenly between 3 needles
(12 stitches per needle).
Place marker

Rounds 1 through 6:
K1, p2, k6, p2, k1

Round 7: Cable round

Repeat rounds 1 through 7 six
times, or until glove measures
seven inches

Repeat rounds 1 through 6
two times more, omitting cable
round.

Next round:

Needle 1: K1, p2, k6, p2, k1
Needle 2: k1, p2, k1. Using
waste yarn, knit next four
stitches. Slip them purlwise to
left hand needle and knit over
the waste yarn with working
yarn. K1, p2, k1.

Needle 3: K1, p2, k6, p2, k1

Repeat rounds 1 through 6.

Work 6 rounds of seed stitch

Cast off.



Thumb:

Remove waste yarn and pick up
live stitches. There should be
eight total. Starting with the bot-
tom right stitch, knit across, pick
up two stitches between top and
bottom rows, knit across top row,
pick up two stitches between top
and bottom row. Divide evenly.

K 3 rounds.

Bind off loosely.

Weave in ends.
